BIG SUBS WERE PLANNED BEFORE WAR BROKE OUT

Feats Equal to That of "Deutschland" Already Performed.

By Special Wire to the Courier. London, July 12.—The Manchester Guardian referring to the German submarine Deutschland, says that plans for submarines of 2,000 to 4,000 tons existed in Germany and England before the war, but that such vessels were not built because of the time required to submerge them and the impossibility of submerging in shallow water. It points out that the Australian submarine A-E went from Australia to the Dardanelles and says that if the captain and the crew of the Deutschland are members of the Imperial navy the submarine may be dealt with as a naval auxiliary. Otherwise she is a blockade runner which could be ordered to stop, and if she attempted to submerge it would be justifiable to sink her.
