A telegram received from Jack McAuliffe at Hot Springs, Arkansas, announces that he is in excellent health. It had been reported that he was dying with consumption.

William Maier, of Wheeling, W. Va., who over a week ago shot his wife because she would not kiss him, came back and was arrested at the grave where she was buried.

Louis T. Grant, chief deputy sheriff of Shelby county, Alabama, and acting sheriff, has absconded with \$10,000 of the people's money. The money was lost in gambling in futures.

Mrs. Mary Lee, the handsome young daughter of South Carolina parents, committed suicide in a New York lying-in hospital by throwing herself from a second-story window.

It turns out that Harry Cecil Whitehair, a trusted clerk in the U. S. National Bank, Wall street, New York, stole \$30,072 from the bank. On Nov. 14 last he went out to buy a sailing vessel on that route. The distance is 3,900 miles.

FOUND AT LAST!
An Alleged Solution of the Labor Problem.

WASHINGTON, April 15.—There is a novel proposition now before the House Committee on Labor. Hon. W. E. Gladstone, Cardinal Gibbons, the late Secretary Windom, H. C. Baird, and the Hon. J. P. Pennington, President of the Federation of Labor, Governor Pattison, of Pennsylvania, T. V. Powderly and Robert G. Ingersoll have all in favor of the proposition and the argument in its favor has been made.

More than 3,000 cotton operatives have been locked out at Hylwood, England, and there is little hope of a peaceful settlement. The steel workers of the west of Scotland have received notice of a 10 per cent. reduction of wages.

There is no marked change in the aspect of the Hamilton molders' strike.

The compositors on the Victoria, B. C., News staff are out on strike in support of their foreman as opposed to the position taken by the manager.

On Wednesday two Canadian seamen, sailing under the United States flag on merchant vessels, were seized at Buffalo under the new law and sent back to Canada. Joseph Norcross and Robert Chalmers are their names. Robert Turner, a Brantford carpenter, came to work for the Wagner Palace Car Co., but was refused employment under instructions from the customs house. The Buffalo Times denounces the proceeding.

The train, shop and section men all along the line of the Erie road are discontented because of the reduction in the working force, and threats of a strike are heard.

The contest between the Firemen's and Seamen's Unions and the Shipowners' Federation over the question of the employment of non-union men is being vigorously waged in the Northern English ports. The masters intend to employ non-unionists at lower wages than the unionists, and they say that many unionists have expressed a desire to accept the reduced rate rather than see their families starve; but thus far the unions have held their members well in hand, and prevented any extensive break in their ranks.
