FRANCE FORCED TO IMPORT ALL COMMON LABOR

Williams Finds Republic Employing Thousands of Unskilled Aliens.

REPLACE DEAD POILUS

Preference of Steel Plant Employees For British-Made Tools Marked.

WHITING WILLIAMS is telling London Advertiser readers what he learned about the European laborers' thoughts, work and play while he toiled as a common laborer in the mines and mills of France, Belgium and Germany. You can learn at first hand many of the things the experts may mull over soon at the Washington arms conference. This is Williams' third article.

BY WHITING WILLIAMS.

At the steel plant in Douai my job was to help two others cut a lot of heavy steel bars to building lengths with a big saw imported from England.

Oddly enough, an English "tommy" was in charge of our gang. He had run away from home into the army and had fought for the world.

When he came to town with the English to help drive out the invaders in October, 1919, he found the girl he had been looking for all over the seven seas. He was perfectly certain it would take a "mighty big job" to get him away to any other part of the world now.

France is suffering less from unemployment than either Canada, America or Great Britain.

Since the war she has employed thousands of Poles, Belgians and Italians as unskilled workers. She needs them because of the 1,500,000 former workers who now lie under the soil of France or Flanders.

German Devastation.
The invaders certainly did a fine job of destroying the factories of this "Pittsburgh district" of France. Almost on the very spot where I worked they had a huge shop for the soldiers all during the war. When the time came to leave, they took acetylene torches and cut in two the steel stanchions holding up the roof—besides using hammers on every piece of machinery.

This desperate destruction was done not so much by the soldiers as by engineers and statisticians employed in all sort of "commercial department," working separately from but in co-operation with the army. This department sent back to the chambers of commerce at home a detailed report telling them just exactly how many years and months they could expect to be free from French competition in the world's markets.

The amazing thing is that such good progress could be shown in cleaning away the refuse and carting the tons of ruined stanchions and the other rusty ruin of ruination off to world earth furnaces for making fresh steel.

And no one would want to meet a cleaner lot of workmen than these mechanists. Even on the hottest days they were unwilling to open up their well-laundered jumpers which buttoned up in a military fashion about their necks. A man who did not start off the week with a well-laundered suit of "blues," as they call their overalls, would lose caste.

Like British Tools.
They were equally careful about their work. Where we work to an eighth of a sixteenth of an inch they work in millimeters or tenths of millimeters! Every one of them, though, was keen about British machine tools—and the plant was full of them.

The crowd kept on the job pretty well, but when the boss was not looking they indulged in about as much horseplay as in one of our plants here.


