A Fair Attendance and Good Fields of Horses on the Opening Day.

Five hundred lovers of the thoroughbred went over to Hamilton yesterday afternoon and were met by the attendance for the H.C.C. opening day to 3000. The early afternoon at the track was cloudy and before the second race was run a shower of rain came down and continued until the races were over.

Lieut. Governor Kirkpatrick, Sir Francis Smith, Dr. Andrew Smith, Capt. Kirkpatrick, W. G. Murdoch, R. G. McCulloch and a jolly party of ladies were among the Torontonians present. The well-appointed grounds and well-looked after horses at noon. All the Ambitious City's smart people were there and the ladies in stylish and becoming costumes graced the members' portion of the stand.

Mr. Seagram landed two races, Messrs. Duggan, Hendry, Dymond and Deane one. He divided the riding honors with Regan, each winning twice, Dunlop and Doane finishing first in the other two races.

The races were evenly divided between favorites and outsiders, Halting, Joe Miller and Flap standing up for the first five, Pops, 15 to 1, Coquette, 3 to 1, and Gonzales, at 3 to 1, were the long shots to pass Judge Pringle first.

Foam was in the lead in the books for second and third places, but easily took first money, Panniss getting the place by a scant neck from the favorite, Morphias.

Halting won the second event as everyone expected, although Superior made the running to the stretch and kept the place from Rosemary, who came up strongly at the finish.

Coquette handled her 115 lbs. manly in the Hamilton race and in the smart field, St. Michael defeating Saragosa and Stoneham for the place.

The jumping race was in favor of the favorite, Flap Flap. Hamilton was allowed back and sent Kings County well over the jumps and along with it was dangerous. Quonki looked last and fell at the first jump. Fellowship threw his rider at the water jump.
