MONUMENT OF OSCAR WILDE Weird Figure in Assyrian Style to Be Placed Over Grave.

The monument consists of a collosal male figure in the highest relief against a huge block of Derbyshire limestone. The modeling is ultra-conventionalized in Assyrian style with huge square wings occupying the upper half of the block. The face of the figure is that of Wilde, but it is curiously flattened with the full expression of sensuous defiance. The whole effect is welrd and abnormal and in keeping with the genius and the career commemorated.
