

Sheweth,

That by an Order from the Court of Chester, a Road was Laid out about the Year 1698. From the great Valley to Chester Town, and Afterwards Opened by the Supervisors of the several Townships, through which it passed, and Called, and known by the Name of Edgmont great Road; But the said Road having not been Laid out by Course, & Distance; Several Persons have fenced in, & a Cross the said Road, & turned the same into some Inconmodious Places; And the Inhabitants having Neglected to Open the same, of a Necessary Breadth, in the Places where such Removeals have rendered it uncertain: The sd. Road is now become unfit to pass with Carts, and Carriages; from the Lower parts of Goshen, to the Town of Chester aforesd., by reason of Several Roads Leading into the same, from Mills & Iron-Works, &c. And we Therefore desire you will be Pleased to Appoint Six Indifferent Men, to Mark Out the sd. Road, & take the Course, and Distance thereof, as near where the same have heretofore been used, as may be with Conveniency to the Travellers of the said Road, and make Return thereof to the Next Court.
