## MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL RELATIONS TO VISIT GHANA AND CAMEROON

The Honourable Jean-Luc Pepin, Minister for External Relations, will begin a six-day journey to Ghana and Cameroon on February 25, 1984.

During his visit, Mr. Pepin will meet with senior authorities of the two countries and will review bilateral and multilateral questions of common interest with his hosts. His mission will also serve to encourage Canadian trade relations with these countries and to promote sales of Canadian goods and services.

In Ghana, Mr. Pepin will inaugurate, in the presence of His Excellency Chairman Jerry Rawlings, the \$23 million Petro-Canada International Assistance Corporation offshore drilling project, aimed at assisting the country to develop its petroleum resources.

In Cameroon, the last country he will visit, he will sign agreements to enable the Cameroonian Government to purchase goods and services in Canada.
