McDOUGALL TO SPEAK AT ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF CBIE IN SASKATOON

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, will be in Saskatchewan, October 15 and 16, to deliver a keynote address at the annual conference of the Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE), as well as to talk to community groups about the constitution.

In addition to addressing the CBIE conference, Mrs. McDougall will open the first Canada-Europe Round Table on Higher Education, which will be broadcast simultaneously via satellite to educational centres in Vancouver, Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto and Halifax.

The Minister will meet with University of Saskatchewan staff involved in international projects and will speak to the Saskatoon Council of Women. Mrs. McDougall will also go to Prince Albert, where she will speak to a public forum on the constitution.
