BY-LAW No. 4.

For Tazing School Section No. 18, in the Township of London.

[PASSED FEBRUARY 13, 1850.]

WHEREAS the trustees of school section No. 18, in the township of London, have petitioned this council, praying that a tax may be levied and collected from the inhabitants of said section sufficient to raise the sum of twenty-five pounds currency [over and above the expense of collection], for the purpose of furnishing the school house, and fencing the land upon which the school house is erected.

Be it therefore Enacted, by authority of the Municipal council of the township of London, that the sum of twenty-five pounds currency, be levied and collected from the inhabitants and landholders of said school section, during the current year, for the purposes above mentioned, to be assessed equally on all the rateable property in said school section, and to be applied for the purposes above mentioned.

BY-LAW No. 5.

For Tazing School Section No. 23, in the Township of London, for the undermentioned purposes.

[PASSED FEBRUARY 13, 1850.]

WHEREAS the trustees of School Section No. 23 have applied to this council for a tax to be levied and collected from the rateable property of the inhabitants of said school section, during the current year, for the purpose of liquidating the debt incurred by said trustees, in erecting the school house in the aforesaid section.
