Dr. Conwell Declares In His Famous Lecture.

Delivering the most quoted lecture in the world, Dr. Russell H. Conwell last evening told the hundreds of people who had gathered to hear him on the closing night of London's 1918 Chautauque that anybody who is rich or great who so desires. The only thing about it is to go about it in the right way, and finding the right way is the secret of success.

Previous to the introduction of Dr. Conwell, an enjoyable program was presented by Charles E. Clarke, baritone and entertainer; Rachel Clark, violinist, and Earl Victor Pratt.

The enjoyable and informing Chautauque week was brought to a close with last evening's offering, the audience expressing a practically unanimous wish for a return next year.

Referring to the welcome and courtesy extended to the Chautauque course in London, Professor Swink, who has been in charge here, stated that in no place has greater encouragement been received, referring especially to the support of the "progressive press."
