A good laying breed of hen will produce 200 eggs a year. At a low estimate of ten dozen eggs a year for 110,000,000 hens, the annual production of eggs would reach 1,100,000,000 dozen.

Domestic Consumption.

At the present time we consume 23 dozen eggs per head of population in Canada each year. This might be increased to 50 dozen, making a total of about 350,000,000 dozen. We use less than 25,000,000 dozen of our eggs at the present time for incubation. This could be increased to 50,000,000 dozen.
