LEGAL.

Times and Places of Sitting of the several Civil and Criminal Courts, in the Judicial District of Simcoe, (1874.)

- GENERAL(CRIMINAL) SESSIONS, and Sittings for trial of issues in fact, with a jury. June 9th, December 8th.
- COUNTY COURT SITTINGS, for trial of issues of fact, without a jury. April 6th, October 5th.
- TERMS OF COUNTY AND SURROGATE COURTS, commence Mondays—January 5th, April 6th, July 6th, October 5th.
- COURT FOR SPEEDY TRIAL, by judge, without jury in criminal cases—not being capital felonies, &c. Sittings as occasion requires after commitment of prisoners.
- UNDER THE INSOLVENT ACT. Sittings on Mondays and Thursdays in each week as occasion requires—except in vacation, [July 1st to 21st August.]

(All the above Courts sit at the Court House, Barrie.)
