"Yet as *child desertion* in certain cases falls little short of this crime (murder), it is recommended that every effort be made to obtain the mother along with the child, so as to secure, as far as practicable, *wet nursing* for the infants.

"And that they be urged to exercise still greater vigilance in the enforcement of rules that have produced such good results.

Carried unamiously.

3rd Resolution moved by Dr. Scott, seconded by Mrs. Selwyn :--

"That a vote of thanks be tendered to the gentlemen of the Advisory Committee, who have so warmly and successfully interested themselves in collecting Funds for the erection of the new Building, and that they be requested to continue their valuable efforts to that end."

Carried unanimously.

The following gentlemen, Revds. J. S. Black, L. Gaetz, and Drs. Scott and Bell having spoken to the several resolutions, the Rev. Mr. Gaetz closed the meeting with prayer.
