The Synod then adjourned till to-morrow at Ten o'clock, and was closed with prayer.

## DIET III.

## St. Andrew's Church, York, 3rd August, 1833.

The Synod met and was constituted with prayer.

Mr. William Duff Miller, from the Kirk Session of Niagara, was added to the Sederunt.

The Minutes were then read, when Mr. Mathieson having complained that Dr. Harkness' adherence to the reasons of dissent, given in by Mr. McKenzie, as intimated in his letter to the Moderator, had not been entered upon the Record, moved, that the adherence of Dr. Harkness, expressed in his letter to the Moderator of 24th July, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-three, be received and recorded in the Minutes.

When the Clerk moved as an amendment, that no adherence to reasons of dissent, except those which are given in *instanter*, be entered upon the Record; but that upon intimation being given to the Clerk, any member may have his name added to those already on the original Document.

Whereupon the Roll being called, and the votes taken, Mr. Mathieson's motion was carried by a majority of one, and Dr. Harkness' adherence ordered to be received and recorded.

The Synod resolved to hold a Diet for Prayer at half-past seven o'clock on the evening of Monday next.
