B., was town treasurer of Ashland for four years; selectman twenty-one years, and eighteen years postmaster. He is a member of the F. & A. M., Royal Arch Chapter, Knights Templar and Shrine, Oddfellows.

Herbert W. Kitchen, of Presque Isle, was born in Carleton County. He is forty-four years old, is a Republican, Congregationalist, married, and a farmer. He was educated in the common schools and Shaw Business College, was a selectman for three years, director Aroostook Co-operative Co., director of Presque Isle National Bank, member of F. & A. M., and twice master Marysville Chapter, Grange No. 153.

Albert M. Smith, of Luidow, Me.

Albert M. Smith, of Lúdiow, Me., was born in Kings County, N. B., fifty-five years ago. He was educated in the schools of New Brunswick and Houlton, and is a Republican. He was six years on board of selectmen, town clery, superintendent of schools and a member of executive committee, Aroostook Farm Bureau, and a member of the House in 1921.




