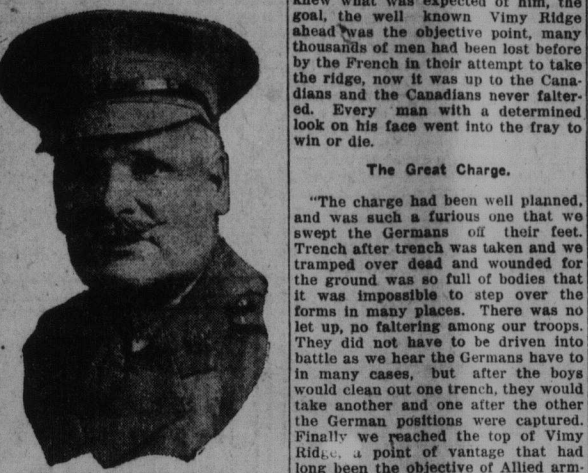

**MAJOR J. O. SHARP TELLS OF FOUR DAYS OF BATTLE FIGHTING**  
Pipers in Highland Costume Played Men Into Charge at 5.30 a. m. in Pouring Rain — St. John Man's Vivid Description of Canadians' Great Victory.

Many persons who enjoy a quiet life at home have an idea that music is not used on the battlefield during the present great European war, that it is not like olden days, when soldiers went into battle to the inspiring music of the drum and fife or the pipers. Although there is undoubtedly but little music in the front lines during a battle, according to Major J. O. Sharp, a former St. John boy, the Canadians went into the big charge on the Germans at Vimy Ridge with the inspiring music of the Princess Patricia Pipe Band.

While in St. John.  
Major Sharp was stationed here some weeks with a battalion, and on arrival in England the battalion was broken up and Major Sharp was attached to another unit. Major Sharp

was the only St. John man in the 18th Regiment and he was warmly welcomed back to his native city. On account of it being his old home, Col. Greer placed that famous battalion in charge of Major Sharp on a couple of special route marches through the city and the gallant St. John soldier and the men under him came in for a great deal of applause from admiring citizens as they marched through the different streets of the city.

**Captain Miller Receives Letter.**  
Captain J. R. Miller of the 62nd received a letter from Major Sharp, who gained his first military knowledge in this St. John regiment when he resided in St. John and in that Major Sharp gives a most graphic description of the famous charge of the Canadians and the capture of Vimy Ridge from the Germans, a victory which placed the Canadians again before the whole world, as among the greatest fighters in history.

**Description of Battle.**  
Major Sharp describes the battle as the first big one he participated in, but modestly states that he does not expect that it will be his last. "Of course," he said, "we have had several small battles since that of Vimy, but nothing quite so large. I will not be long before we get other large ones." The weather on the morning of the famous Vimy charge was as bad as one could imagine. There was a heavy downpour of rain, every officer and man being soaked to the skin. At 5.30 o'clock that morning twelve miles of good British artillery beched forth a regular storm of heavy steel into the Germans. It was only a few minutes after the artillery had poured tons upon tons of shell into the Germans that the order was given for the infantry to charge and we went at it in the way that Canadian soldiers rank among the best of fighters. There was not a murmur among the brave boys from the land of the Maple Leaf, and all appeared anxious to get into the fight. The pipe band started up an inspiring air and in their Highland costume played the men into the charge.
