Very few changes occur in the St. John market this week except in meats and oats and feeds. Country beef has receded from 11c and 15c to 10c and 14c, western beef from 18c and 23c to 17c and 18c; case eggs have advanced from 50c and 52c to 52c and 53c; veal from 18c and 19c to 19c and 20c; tub butter from 44c and 48c to 45c and 50c; roll butter from 38c and 40c to 40c and 42c; chicken from 40c to 42c; fowl from 30c to 35c.

In feeds oats, car lots, bushels, have advanced from 90c to \$1.00 to 95c and \$1.00, hay, car lots, ton, from \$20 to \$22, to \$22 to \$24; hay, small lots, tons, from \$22 and \$24 to \$24 and \$26.
