**PORT OF ST. JOHN,**

**Brought Sugar Cargo.**  
The Furness liner after B. Munson,  
arrived in port yesterday from Cuba  
with a cargo of 25,000 bags of raw  
sugar for the Atlantic Refineries.

**Also Brings Sugar Cargo.**  
The R. M. S. P. Chignecto, from  
Bermuda and the West Indies, brought  
a cargo of 2,500 tons of raw sugar,  
1,200 puncheons of molasses and gen-  
eral produce from the south. She  
also carried a large passenger list  
and considerable mail.

**St. John-Cuba Service.**  
Early next month the new sailings  
between St. John and Havana by way  
of Cuba will be inaugurated. Already  
booking for freight accommodation  
are being made.

**Buyers Displaced.**  
During the recent storm several  
buyers in the local marine and fisher-  
ies district were displaced. They will  
be positioned again as soon as pos-  
sible.

**In The Wake of the Storm.**  
The S.S. Polar Land, abandoned at  
sea, is reported to have sunk. The  
Furness liner Kanawha is reported to  
have gone to her assistance from  
Halifax.

The collier Tolamachus was reported  
to be in trouble off the coast of  
Nova Scotia during Sunday night.  
The towboat Merimac was sunk in  
Halifax harbor Sunday.

The R.R. Platte is aground on Sable  
Island. She was a transport during the  
South African war.

The S.S. Gravelote is also in trouble  
off Sable Island and the D. O. S. Aran-  
more has gone to her assistance.

A hull, bottom up, was seen east  
of Sable Island yesterday. It is  
supposed to be that of a 200 foot  
four-masted vessel under construction  
and was wrecked in the recent storm.
