GIBSON, THOMAS. (*East Huron.*)

S. of Mr. Thomas Gibson. B. at Greenlaw, Berwickshire, Scot., 8 Jan. 1825. Ed. there. M., 1st, 1854, Miss Elizabeth Hudson (she d.); 2nd, Sarah, eld. dau. of Richard Young, Esq., of Lakelet. Learned the trade of a millwright and worked at it in Scot. some years before settling in Can. in 1855. Elected to the Municipal Council of Howick in 1858 and was Reeve for some years. An unsuccessful candidate at g. e. 1867. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g. e. 1871; re-elected at g. e. 1875, '79, and at last g. e. A Liberal, and supporter of Mr. Mowat.—*Wroxeter, Ont.*

GILMOUR, JOHN TAYLOR, M.D. (*West York.*)

S. of Thomas Gilmour, farmer and lumber manufacturer; mother a descendant of a U.E. Loyalist. B. in the Tp. of Clark, Co. of Durham, Ont., 3 March, 1855. Ed. at Port Hope High Sch. and at Trinity Medical Coll., Toronto, where he graduated M. D. M., 17 Sept. 1878, Emma Hawkins, of Canton, near Port Hope. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last g. e. GOULD, ISAAC JAMES. (*North Ontario.*)

Descended from a Quaker family, formerly resident in Pennsylvania. Father, the late Joseph Gould, represented North Ontario in the Parlt. of the Prov. of Can. for seven years. B. at Uxbridge, 13 Nov., 1839, and ed. there. M., 23 Sept., 1862, Rebecca, dau. of Ira and Nancy Chapman, Uxbridge. Is a farmer, lumberman and owner of grist and woollen mills.
