BILL.

An Act to specify the time when an Act of the present Session relating to the Townships of Kingston and Pittsburgh shall come in force.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in this present Session intituled, "An Act to attach a certain portion of the Township of Kingston, in the County of Frontenac, to the Township of Pittsburgh for Municipal and other purposes" it is amongst other things in effect provided that all that portion of the Township of Kingston in the said County of Frontenac in the Province of Canada lying to the East of the Channel of the Rideau Canal should, for municipal and all other purposes, be attached to and form part of the Township of Pittsburgh;—And whereas the time when the said Act shall come in force is not mentioned therein, and it is desirable that the same should take effect from and after the thirty first day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifty three;

Be it therefore enacted &c., That the said in part recited Act shall come in force and take effect from and after the thirty first day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifty three, and not before.
