

Survey to be
made of the

Such Survey
to be conclu-
sive.

That it shall be lawful for the Honorable the Commissioner of Crown Lands, to cause a Survey to be made of the said Broken Concession A, on the Ottawa, in the Township of Nepean, from where the Grand or Ottawa River intersects or cuts off the said Broken Concession A, at lot number twenty-eight, to the present established and recognized boundary of the Concession between the Ottawa and Rideau fronts; the said Survey to be so made as to give an equal width to each of the several lots as originally intended, and as stated in the report of the said John Stegmal, in the preamble to this Bill mentioned; and the said Survey so to be made shall be held to be the true Survey of the said lots, and the boundaries to be planted by the Surveyor employed to make the same shall be held to be the true boundaries of the said lots respectively, as originally surveyed and as granted by the Crown, as if such boundaries had been referred to in the Letters Patent granting the said lots respectively.

Public Act.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Act.
