

## BILL.

An Act to extend and amend an Act passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "*An Act to provide for the appointment of Justices of the Peace for the more remote parts of this Province.*"

**W**HEREAS it is expedient that more ample provisions should be made for the appointment of Justices of the Peace to act and have jurisdiction in the remote parts of this Province; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

Preamble.

- 5 That all the provisions of the Act passed in the ninth year of the Reign of Her Majesty, and intituled "*An Act to provide for the appointment of Justices of the Peace for the more remote parts of this Province,*" shall be deemed to apply and shall apply, to any Justice of the Peace to be appointed at any place north of Aylmer, on the River Ottawa, or of La Grande Baie on the River Saguenay, or in any place east of Tadousac on the north shore of the River and Gulf of St. Lawrence, although the said places may be within the limits of a constituted District in this Province; and also to any officer or officers in command of any of Her Majesty's vessels in the Gulf and River St. Lawrence, and to any other person who may have been or shall have been appointed a Justice of the Peace, with instructions to act as such in the Gulf and River St. Lawrence, and on the shores of the said Gulf and River, for the better protection of those of Her Majesty's subjects who are or shall be engaged in the trade of the Fisheries in the said Gulf and River, in the same manner as if the said places and persons above mentioned and described were specially named and described in the said Act, anything to the contrary in the said Act contained notwithstanding.

Provisions of 9 Vic., cap. extended to Justices appointed in certain places, and for certain purposes.
