

such Corporations aforesaid, to pay all damages as shall have been occasioned by his unlawful act or acts ; which money, when recovered, shall be applied under the direction of the Directors for the reparation and reconstruction of the property destroyed, and members of any such Company may be competent witnesses in such suits.

Directors may call for instalments.

X. And be it enacted, That the Directors of any Company formed under the provisions of this Act shall have full power to call for instalments on the sums which shall be subscribed for, and to appoint a time for the payment thereof, and if the same shall not then be paid, the right of any subscriber, and every instalment he may have formerly paid, shall be forfeited, and he shall be held not to have subscribed, unless the Directors shall think expedient to remit such forfeiture, which they may do in their discretion, if the instalments be paid with interest within one year after the day when it ought to have been paid.

Public Act.

XI. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Act.
