Sir-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, enclosing Mr. Forest Bailiff Belrose's report on and valuation of Lot 33, Con 1, W.B.R., St. Edmund, and in reply to inform you that as you consider this valuation too low, you may sell this Lot at the price which you, yourself, recommend, viz \$30.00 cash, the land without any conditions as to settlement and the timber free of dues.
