"I suggest to the government the desirability of substituting the work "five" for the word "thirty". Five years is the life of a parliament, and I cannot think it quite consonant with the ideas of the right hon. gantleman as heretofore expressed that this parliament should bind the hands of future parliaments. I am quite aware of the fact that it would be quite competent for succeeding parliaments to change that figure to forty or to ten; they would have that power, but a vested interest is acquired when a statute of this kind is passed by parliament; the commission naturally expects that that is the end of it. I suggest that instead of making provision for thirty years we endeavour to deal with this matter during the lifetime parliament will have passed, but I think the right hon. gentleman would be quite within the general constitutional practice if he said, "I desire that a given sum shall be available for this commission during the lifetime of the parliament over which I am the directing head".
