which passes through the Indian
Reserve, at what is known as
the Tucker Creek Settlement in the
Township of Howland.

3rd \$1000⁰⁰ towards the con-
-struction of a bridge between
Kassie Island and Manitoulin
Island.

I may add that the Department is
in communication with the Indian
Superintendent on Manitoulin Island
relative to the work to be done
on these Roads &c.
