Ottawa, May 16, 1911.

Sir,-

I have to request you to be good enough to make the necessary valuation of the small extra width of land containing 0.09 acres and separately the improvements thereon, if any, desired by the Canadian Northern Pacific Railway in the Matsqui Main reserve as shown on the plan attached to the Surrender (in duplicate) herewith enclosed. You should consult the Indian Council and the Indian specially interested and they should concur with your reasonable valuation.

You should then take the currender from the Indians and you are hereby authorized to take the same.

You will please be careful to comply with the provisions of the Indian Act relating to the surrender of Indian lands.
