




Sir,-

With reference to the contract to be let for the construction of the Agency building at Metlakatla, I beg to transmit herewith one copy of agreement properly executed and also two copies of a bond as the memorandum on the agreement signed by the sureties is not satisfactory. You should have the bond now transmitted completed by Messrs. Greer and Kennedy and their sureties. You should retain the agreement until the bond is completed and approved by the Department. Upon receipt of which information, you may hand over the copy of the agreement to the contractor. Until then you should retain the cheque for 10 \$ which was deposited with the tender. When the bond is signed one copy should be returned to the Department.
