



Ottawa, 25th November, 1913.

Rev. Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 12th November, I re-enclose herewith the account which you submitted from the Brandon Implement and Manufacturing Company, for expenditure in connection with the Brandon School. The item of \$4.50 for repairs to the pump cannot be paid. This item is a proper charge against the per capita grant to the school. The other charges amounting respectively to .50 cents, \$11.35 and \$29.00 cannot be considered until full details are furnished. You should state to what use the plates and castings were put. The account which you submitted under cover of your letter of the 11th November from the Manitoba Engines Ltd., is also returned. It cannot be paid as the expenditure covered by the same is properly chargeable to the per capita grant to the school.
