(b) Maint - Tech Egpt

- (i) The Pilot Model of the Unit Maint Veh for the Res Army has been approved. Work has commenced on the remaining eleven webs.
- (ii) Replacement parts have been installed in Users' Trial Sets at National Research Council 2 Fd Sta.

(c) Modification of War Eqpt

At a meeting to discuss interchangeability of parts between Cdn Predictors AA No 3 and American Directors M6, it was established that any necessary fitting, with the exception of Computing Units, can be carried out in the field with existing Wksp facilities.

- (i) Exhaust Smoke Emitter Carbonization tests have been completed with out encountering difficulties. A new style diffuser-jet-plug of stainless steel is being made.
- (ii) 2-in Bomb-Thrower in Armd Car Installation drawing has been completed.
- (111) Stowage Grizzly I All requested modifications are to be included in production.

(b) Proving Ground

- (1) Wksp Lorry 6 x 6 User triels were completed
- (ii) Exhaust Smoke Emitter The coking of nozzles is being examined.

(c) Small Arms

- (i) Cdn Quad 20-mm AA Mtg Firing practices recently completed against drogues indicate that the eqpt would be most useful.
- (ii) Cdn Single 20-mm AA Mtg This mount performed very well during brief firing trials conducted against drogues.

 After completion of road trials, it was returned to the manufacturer for modifications in preparation for shipment to the UK.
- (111) Single 20-mm AA Mtg M2El Having been subjected to drogue firing trials, it compares favourably with other similar mountings.

(d) Design

- (1) Scout Car Lynx I Improved pilot model will be completed in two weeks.
- (ii) Universal Scout Car The first pilot model will be tested using temporarily the standard 95 HP Ford Engine. This weh is radically different from any other model produced in Canada to date and finelization of design is not imminent.

- (iv) 1500-Gal Petrol-Tanker Semi-Trailer Pilot model using 3-ton 4 x 4 133-in WB Chassis is under constr.
