VI. That every member shall provide himself with a copy of these articles, the name of every member, the place of his abode, store, &c. When any member shall remove to another dwelling, store, &c. he shall inform the clerk thereof, who shall insert the same in the next notification for meeting, on penalty of Two Shillings; and each member shall conform his articles thereto and produce the same at the next meeting, on penalty of Two Shillings.

VII. That we may distinguish the members of this Society from others, there shall be a Watchword without which no person is to be admitted by the member who shall act as centinel at the door of the house of the member in danger, unless his admittance be requested by said member—the watchword to be altered by consent of the Society, and any member not being able to tell it at each meeting time of alarm, or when called upon by the clerk, when demanded by the clerk, shall pay Two Shillings, and if any member
