Meet in Medicine Hat To-Day.

Today the divisional superintendents of the C. P. R. met at Medicine Hat to exchange ideas in connection with the operation of the road. In addition to the superintendents of the division there will be present the mechanical staff, the maintenance of way staff, the passenger, freight and fuel agents and the car distributor—between forty and fifty officials in all. Among those present will be A. Price, general superintendent, Calgary; district superintendents J. A. Niblock, Calgary, G. Erickson, Cranbrook, J. Brownlee, Moose Jaw and J. H. Lawrence, Medicine Hat; divisional engineer N. E. Brooks and Mr. Woodhouse.

It is expected that the meeting will result in being a great help to the heads of the different departments of the division. The special cars began to arrive early this morning. The mayor placed the city hall at the disposal of the officials and a meeting was held in the council chamber at 10 o'clock, most of the railroaders being present. When seen at noon by the representative of the Times Mr. Price stated that the matters under discussion, which relate to maintenance of way and general operation of the road, were of a private nature and there was nothing to give the press. As the Times goes to press they are again in conference.

The newsboys for The Times have put up a great record. In September the boys started a competition among the boys to run until the end of the year. The boys found The Times easy to sell, and although several weeks were missed by all of them, the figures show the demand for the paper.

John Littleford secured first place with a total of 291. Next to him came Donald Ross who, although he did not start until October, ran up 198. The third place was taken by Percy Urwin, who, with only six weeks' selling, had the great total of 163. Barrie Glover was out only half the week but his number was 116. John Poir, who is The Times "devil" now, was on a fair way to win the prize, when he stepped into the ink job, as in the first six weeks of selling he had disposed of 104 Times.
