**Valuable Suggestions.**

Editor Evening Telegram.

Dear Sir.—The confusion and disappointments connected with the recent Civic Election prompts me to make a suggestion or two that if carried out in future will likely obviate a recurrence of the trouble experienced on Thursday last. I would suggest that instead of employing enumerators to take the list of voters, that this work be attended to by the City Council clerical staff. It would be a very simple matter for the City Council in future to advertise say a month or two before an election that a "Registry" of voters would be taken at the City Hall. All the particulars such as apartment houses, list of delinquents etc., are in the possession of the Council, and without entailing any hardship on the city officials, the list of voters could be taken by the "Taxpayers calling at the City Hall during a specified period, and having their duly qualified names placed on the Registry kept for this purpose. When this Registry was completed it could be handed to the Returning Officer for distribution to the different Booth rooms on polling day, and should be the final list of voters for the time being.

In addition to preventing a repetition of Thursday's fiasco, the very formal attendance at the "Court of Revision," usually called for at Election times, could be "out" altogether, and all or nearly all of last week's trouble and annoyance obviated. Under this arrangement, any one not taking interest enough in civic affairs to call at the City Hall to see if his name were registered, would have no one to blame for being disfranchised, and of being deprived of the privilege of voting for the candidate of his choice. The public, Mr. Editor, will look to the incoming Council to attend to this matter at once and pass a City Ordinance covering this suggestion, and end forever last Thursday's exhibition of carelessness, incompetence and neglect.
