Successor. Ottawa, Sept. 14.-Justice Fournier, of the Supreme Court, has written Sir Hibbert Tupper stating that he will not be able to resume his duties again, so that this disposes of the dispute as to whether Justice Fournier's application for leave of absence six months ago was also to be taken as resignation.

This leaves a vacancy in the Supreme Court which is worth \$6,000 per year. Sir Hibbert Tupper has had an interview with Chief Justice Strong in regard to Justice Fournier's successor.

The position was at one time intended for Hon. A. R. Angers, but he will not now likely get it, since he has left the Cabinet-Mr. Girouard, M.P. for Jacques Cartier, is the most likely man now for the job. Justice Fournier's retiring allowance is \$4,000 a year.
