GOOD SPORT AT NEW ORLEANS.

Jack Lovell, at Long Odds, Wins in a Walk-The Favorites Did Honor With the Field.

NEW ORLEANS, Jan. 6.—Three favorites and one second choice were to-day. The track was fast up to the fourth race, when a heavy rain made it a little muddy.

The feature of the day was the run of Jack Lovell, who won the fourth race in a walk, almost after starting nearly late. He was played as long odds, as his performance since the Chicago race would not indicate that he was in form.

A noticeable thing about his running was that he never broke. His favorite, Rancocas won the first race by a length from Robuff, with Rally two lengths behind.

The second race was won by a length and a half from Victoria, who was in front of Mendiant. Pat Tucker took the lead in the third race and kept it to the finish, winning easily by two lengths.
