tunately I am not qualified to teach music, and I think it will be very much appreciated. I am sure our Indians ought to feel very grateful for the extraordinary kindness shown to them.

I am very glad to say that everything is working smoothly. The attendance at church prayer-meetings and school is indeed very good. There has

been a little sickness among the children, but nothing serious.

I received a box of very nice clothing, etc., from Rat Portage Ladies' Aid. I sent an acknowledgment to the Presbyterian minister. I had no name to write to.
