This book is a valuable contribution to the study of Canadian history for its subject is much larger than its title indicates. In fact it extends at times far beyond the boundaries of the Dominion. The author attempts to account for the American Puritan and his progenitor the English Puritan. The ancient town and fortress of Louisbourg is described and the story of its two sieges told in detail. There is a short account of the struggle between France and England in North America. An interesting sketch of the history of the Dominion of Canada, and of Cape Breton in particular, with a racy chapter on the commercial advantages and picturesque scenery of the island go, with the excellent engravings to make up a book not only of historic value, but of great interest. The style of the author, though uneven, is always interesting and often brilliant.
