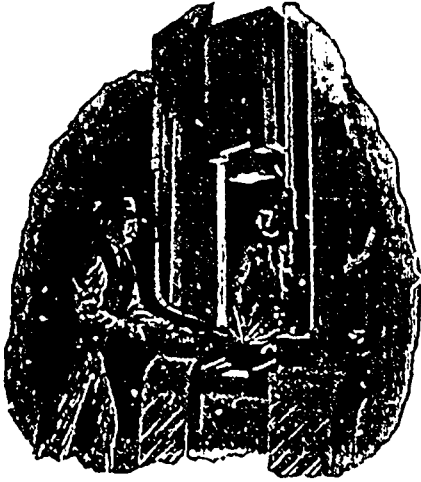


Scientific Forging and High Grade Bicycles.

Many makers use a malleable casting or a sheet steel stamping costing but a few cents.
