HON. EDWARD BLAKE.

THIS gentleman, who is the eldest son of the late Judge Wm. Hume Blake, is generally regarded as the proprietor of the greatest head in Canada. He is a brilliant scholar, a profound lawyer, a fine orator, and a man of the highest personal character. Nature built him on Gladstonian lines, but by some singular oversight she left one or two of the ingredients out. The consequence is that though Mr. Blake is admittedly Canada's foremost man, he has never managed to "get there." As leader of the Liberal party he performed all his duties perfectly, with uniform and unvarying want of success. He is now in retirement from politics, and public life will probably know him no more.
