

- fish livers, roe and milt (soft roe), fresh, frozen, in brine or smoked squid,
fresh or frozen

In our view, it might also be feasible to market various kinds of frozen fish,
such as turbot or Greenland halibut, Atlantic halibut, haddock, sole and rosefish.
Processed surimi (kamaboko) might also prove to be an eminently marketable product.

At present it is not possible for the list of Canadian exports to France to
include molluscs for consumption alive, but we believe it will be possible to work out an
agreement allowing Canadian producers to export mussels, oysters and sea urchins.

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
