THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY HAS CONCLUDED ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF CAMADA FOR THE TRAINING IN CAMADA OF 360 AIRCREW TO MAN A NUMBER OF F86 SABRE AIRCRAFT WHICH HAVE BEEN ALLOTTED: TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC UNDER MUTUAL AID ARRANGEMENTS AND A FURTHER NUMBER OF AIRCRAFT TO BE PURCHASED IN CAMADA. THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY HAS AGREED TO REIMBURSE THE CAMADIAN GOVERNMENT FOR THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE MATO AIR TRAINING ESTABLISHMENT FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF SEVERAL MONTHS TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING OF THE GERMAN AIRCREW. THE TRAINESS ARE EXPECTED TO COMMENCE TRAINING IN CAMADA SOMETIME IN 1957 AND IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE TRAINING WILL BE COMPLETED BY APPROXIMATELY APRIL 1959.
