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LITTON CONTRACT FOR NAVIGATION SYSTEMS
WORTH ADDITIONAL \$60 MILLION

Toronto's Litton Systems Canada Limited has won an additional \$60 million (Canadian) contract to supply LN-35 Inertial Navigation Systems to the U.S. Department of Defense, Roy MacLaren, M.P. for Etobicoke North, announced today on behalf of Trade Minister Ed. Lumley.

Arranged by the Canadian Commercial Corporation, the contract was won under the U.S./Canada Defence Production Sharing Arrangement, and brings the value of the original contract awarded to Litton Canada last March to more than \$110 million.

Canadian Commercial Corporation (CCC) contracts with foreign governments and international agencies on behalf of Canadian suppliers of goods and services. Last year CCC achieved sales of over \$400 million, involving 500 Canadian companies and more than 50 foreign buyers.

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
