PRAYERS.

Mr. Wahn, from the Standing Committee on External Affairs and National Defence, presented the Eighth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference dated November 3, 1969, your Committee has considered the role of the United Nations in the maintenance of peace, the future of peacekeeping operations and Canada's participation in them.

The Committee assigned responsibility for detailed consideration of this subject to its Subcommittee on the United Nations and Peacekeeping, under the Chairmanship of Mr. John Roberts, M.P.

The Subcommittee on United Nations and Peacekeeping has submitted its report to the main Committee. Your Committee has adopted this report, with amendments, believing that it contains most useful commentary and recommendations on the role of the United Nations and Canada's participation in peacekeeping operations.
