The Faculty were of opinion that these students should be exempted from attendance at the lectures on Civil Procedure, and that the Governors should be asked to sanction the provision of lectures on School and Parish Law, Redaction des Actes, and the Liabilities of Notaries. Subject to the approval of the Governors the Faculty appointed a Committee consisting of Professors Surveyer, Howard, and Smith to advise upon the appointment of a lecturer and to arrange all necessary details.
