half-yearly return of the receipts and expenditure, assets and liabilities; and shall verify the same with the Accounts and Vouchers relating thereto; and shall either sign the same as found by them to be correct, duly vouched, or shall specially report to the meeting before which the same is laid, in what respects they find it incorrect or unvouched.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE 9.—The Executive Committee shall be authorized under this article to act as an Arbitration Committee, and the said Committee shall consider all disputes, charges, complaints or claims by a member, or persons claiming on account of a member, and report at the next regular meeting of the Veterans.

PRESIDENT.

ARTICLE 10.—It will be the duty of the President to preserve due order and decorum during the meetings, to prevent any infraction of the rules of the Veterans so far as he is able to do so, and see that justice is done between all parties, and that the rules be impartially administered; attend to the opening and closing of and preside over all meetings, and any other duty the nature of his office may require; and is an ex-officio member of all Committees.

VICE-PRESIDENT.
