

169. March Past in Column of Half Preceptories.



The Preceptory will be drawn up in line at about 30 paces opposite the saluting base. The Captain General will then command.



Column of Threes, Threes Right, Quick — March. — On the word MARCH, the whole will move off, and, when it gains proper distance, changes direction by command, *left wheel.*



When the leading three reaches the saluting base, the Captain General will command, column of half Preceptories to the left; the senior subaltern will then command, right half Preceptory threes left, and when the right half Preceptory has marched on in the new direction column distance will halt. The junior subaltern will, at the proper time, give the command, left half Preceptory threes.



left, halt. The Capt. General will then command, *right dress*, when each half Preceptory will be dressed by the right guides.

The senior subaltern will place himself three paces in front of the centre of the right half Preceptory, the adjutant six paces in rear of the left half Preceptory, the junior subaltern three paces in front of the centre of the left half Preceptory and the Capt. General ten paces in front of the centre of the right half Preceptory.
