Thornhill.

The funeral of the late Mr. Job Trott took place yesterday afternoon to the local cemetery. The funeral was conducted by Rev. F. C. Keane, and a large cortege followed the remains. Deceased had resided in the village for over 67 years, and had nearly reached his 90th year. He came here from Devonshire, England, and worked for many years at his calling of a mason, accumulating considerable wealth by dogged perseverance. He was thrice married, but Mr. Jas. Trott of Alma, Michigan, the only surviving son, is still within a few weeks he had been in his usual good health, and his death was not expected. Deceased was a devout member of the local Methodist Church, and some city institutions will benefit by his charity.
