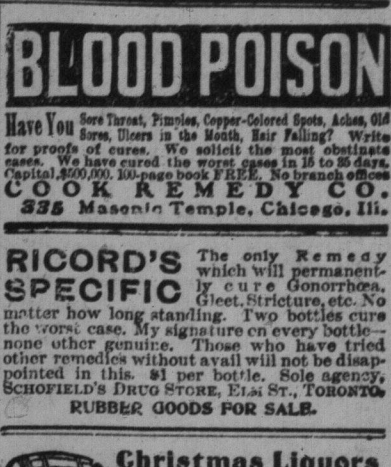

Before Luxembourg Palace, But
Were Suppressed.

After the miners adopted resolutions in favour of a strike throughout the baking trade, the two associations of bakers in the city, the "Bakers' Association" and the "Bakers' Union", issued a statement of protest against the strike of the coal workers, and announced the intention not to resume work until parliament suppressed the municipal employment agencies. The total number of laid workers is 400,000.

Squadrons of mounted troops and police are stationed in various places in the city. On Friday afternoon the bakers of Newport demonstrated in front of the Llanganour Palace, where the senate was sitting, but were suppressed. Later the police prevented gathering of rioters on the stage of the Opera. The determination of the
