methods by electrocution, thanks to an apparatus which he has invented and patented. His device is a cylindrical lantern with two rings suspended one above the other and connected by parallel and vertical chains. These are connected with the source of electricity, which may be either a current providing light or furnished by a little accumulator, in such a fashion that each of the chains always is alive. In the cencorner Rich- ter is a lamp-which attracts the mosquitoes, which begin to buzz around the lamp. Contact with the lamp is fatal. The instant the insect touches two at once with its legs, it establishes a short circuit and immediately is electrocuted. If this apparatus is installed in a bed-

> room, it has only to be lighted a short time before the owner retires to insure quiet night's sleep.
