### SIR ROBERT FAIRLY CAUGHT

When Mr. Turf made the statement in effect that Sir Robert Borden had told a Toronto delegation that there would have to be a "let up in recruiting" there was an indignant denial from Sir Robert. Now Sir Sam says the same thing and offers to produce a "confidential" letter from the premier to substantiate his assertion. But Sir Robert declines to accept the challenge. That the voluntary system was not given a fair trial all Canada has long known. But not only did the government fail to give direction and leadership to the recruiting campaign, it actually retarded recruiting. That is the charge made not once but several times by Sir Sam Hughes. It was repeated formally and explicitly in the house of commons yesterday by the ex-minister of militia, who told how Premier Borden had repeatedly urged him to "let up on recruiting." This is a very serious indictment. It cannot be allowed to drop. Parliament should insist upon the fullest investigation.


